

# **NOBLE TOUR (recommended for groups)**

Montepulciano is home to a wealth of majestic Renaissance palazzos: visit the Palazzo Contucci Ballroom, designed by Antonio da Sangallo the Elder and the sixteenth century Palazzo Ricci, restored by the European Academy of Music and Art, now the site of concerts and conventions. Explore the upper floors and visit the basements, where the Vino Nobile di Montepulciano ages in the wine cellars, witness to the past and present nobility of the town.

- Palazzo Ricci visit; Rosso di Montepulciano DOC and Vino Nobile di Montepulciano DOCG wine tasting.

# **ARTISAN TOUR**

How do artisans create their handmade products? A guide introduces visitors to Montepulciano artisans, their workshops, and their creations. Observe ancient and modern techniques used to create masterpieces in copper, wood, precious metals, leather and ceramics. The Tour concludes with Vino Nobile di Montepulciano DOCG wine tasting in the wine cellars in the old town centre.

# THINGS TO SEE AND DO IN...



## **CETONA: ART, CRAFT AND FLAVOURS**

Discover Cetona and its history, from the Palaeolithic to the present day.
Visit the Monte Cetona Prehistory Museum, walk through the streets of Cetona town centre with an expert guide, and visit a ceramic

craft shop to discover old and new manufacturing techniques used to create ceramic products.

Wrap up your visit with a tasting of typical food from Cetona: Tuscan starter with salami and cheese and "pastrignocchi" (typical

handmade pasta), accompanied by a glass of wine.

## CHIANCIANO TERME: THE ETRUSCAN WAY OF LIFE

Discover all the secrets of the Etruscans. Immerse yourself in the thermal waters of the Theia pools, visit Chianciano Terme Archaeological Museum and treat yourself to an Etruscan dinner in a typical restaurant.

San Casciano dei Bagni beguiles visitors with its charm, which has remained unchanged over time. Stroll through the old town with an experienced guide to learn more about this area and its history, through Etruscan and Roman domination. Take the opportunity to immerse yourself in the ancient pools of Bagno Grande to enjoy the benefits of the warm thermal waters. Wrap up your visit with a Tuscan tasting menu in a farm house immersed in the Tuscan countryside.

- Guided tour of the San Casciano dei Bagni's old town centre and its monuments;
- Walk to the ancient pools of Bagno Grande to soak in the warm thermal waters; Lunch or dinner tasting menu with local produce.

# SARTEANO: INSIDE THE MEDIEVAL CASTLE

Visit Sarteano to learn more about its past, from the Etruscans through the Middle Ages, to the present day. Explore the town with an expert guide, and discover Sarteano's unique features, including the San Martino in Foro church, which houses an Annunciation by Domenico Beccafumi (1546), the medieval castle, a garrison fort that dates back to the 15th century, and the Archaeology Museum, with its exquisite collection of Etruscan treasures.

Wrap up your visit with a typical Tuscan tasting menu in a local restaurant.

## SINALUNGA: THE 4 MEDIEVAL HAMLETS TOUR

Journey back to medieval times on a tour of four unspoilt medieval villages: Sinalunga, Rigomagno, Farnetella and Scrofiano. An expert guide leads visitors through the history and legends of the area, long disputed between Florence and Siena, and accompanies them to the ancient prisons in Sinalunga's Praetorian Palace.

Wrap up your tour with a tasting menu of local produce, including the prized Chianina beef.

# PREHISTORIC EXCURSION IN CETONA

Tour created for families, and for those who want a fascinating educational experience in a stunning natural setting. Monte Cetona Prehistory Museum documents the various stages of human settlements in the territory, from the Palaeolithic to the end of the Bronze Age. Visit a recreation of one of these settlements in the Belvedere Archaeodrome; and explore the Belvedere Archaeological Park the footsteps of the first inhabitants of Monte Cetona.

Wrap up your tour with a tasting menu featuring Cetona's delicious "pastrignocci" pasta.

# THE ETRUSCAN MYSTERIES: SARTEANO, CHIUSI, AND CHIANCIANO TERME

The tour includes lunch at a local restaurant to taste local dishes reinterpreted in an Etruscan style
